





Current situation



SCAK – ALLAKOUADIOKRO – 3 houses for the teachers



BEFORE

1 teacher house in mud. No other houses for teachers in the villages.
Young teachers coming from the city did not want to stay in the village.
Voluntary villagers were teaching the children, without being qualified.

September 2023: 1 teacher
Education fees

After several teachers declined the position due to the harsh living conditions, Mr. Ouattara, a young qualified teacher, chose to stay and support the children in 2023. The remaining teachers were local volunteers without formal training.



September 2025: 4 teachers
Free education

In September 2025, three new teachers joined the school, significantly improving the quality of education for the children. Families no longer need to pay the volunteer teachers, as their salaries are now covered by the government.

Testimonial of M. Ouattara – Teacher and Director of Allakouadiokro school

“When I first arrived in Allakouadiokro, I was disheartened. The chief of the village showed me my house —**a windowless hut inhabited by bats**. I didn't want to stay, but he asked me to help the community.

Visiting the school, I saw volunteer teachers working without proper methods. **I realized I could make a real difference, so I decided to stay.**

At the time, the school was community-run. I initiated the process for official recognition, and today it's part of the national education system. **Every year, the Chocolate Bonus new projects give us fresh motivation**

The new housing is a huge relief. I used to live among bats, and now we have three spacious villas. It's beyond expectations and a source of pride.

We're truly grateful. **What you've done is unmatched in the surrounding villages. Even the inspector was impressed.**

Young teachers from the city often hesitate to stay due to lack of comfort—electricity, clean water, decent housing. They are now more willing to stay. **I am personally planning to bring my wife here, start a family, and settle here for good.”**



PNG 2025 – Maintenance training completed

Objectives

- **Train participants on preventive maintenance** (leaks, blockages and contamination)
- Provide **hands-on skills in repairing common tank/system issues** and troubleshooting failures.
- Educate participants on maintaining water quality, including **cleaning procedures and mitigating risks** like algae growth and mosquito breeding
- **Promote community ownership** and sustainability by fostering shared responsibility, creating maintenance plans, financial investment and ensuring long-term system functionality.


